The incumbent will be responsible for overseeing the planning and coordinating of Traffic Law Enforcement operations and initiatives in a collaborative approach with National, Provincial and Municipal counterparts. The incumbent will be responsible for directing and overseeing the deployment of Traffic Law Enforcement operations in the Provinces as well as Specialised Traffic Law Enforcement activities. The incumbent will be responsible for overseeing the setting, evaluation and monitoring of all Traffic Law Enforcement Norms and Standards and Implementation thereof.

**Requirements:** A Bachelors Degree or equivalent qualification, a relevant post-graduate qualifications would be an added advantage. Candidate must possess 10 years relevant experience of which 5 years in a senior managerial role. Experience dealing with multiple Road Traffic Law Enforcement is essential.
