



RTMC's Festive Season Grocery Hamper Community Project.

The Corporation in partnership with the North West Department of Community Safety and Transport hosted the RTMC Festive Season Grocery Hampers Community Project in Lonely Park, Ward 29, Mahikeng. The event was hosted on the 24th December 2016 and focused on households headed by Children, Youth and Vulnerable Old Citizens.

A total number of two hundred and twenty (220) households from the surrounding disadvantaged communities benefitted from the initiative in the North West Province. MEC. Dr. M.N. Motlhabane addressed the event which was supported by the Mayor and Premier Offices in the province, the Department of Arts and Culture, Social Development, Department of Health and local municipalities and councillors. The event also received positive media coverage and highlighted the need to provide support to the less fortunate during the holiday season. Furthermore, the Corporation partnered with the Department of Transport hosted the Deputy Minister's Road Safety Child Headed Household Educare Initiative.

The Deputy Minister, Hon. Sindisiwe Chikunga handed over grocery packs to one hundred (100) households from disadvantaged households, which were affected by road crashes.

The handover event took place on the 19th December 2016 in the rural Engoje, Louwsburg, Kwa-Zulu Natal.
