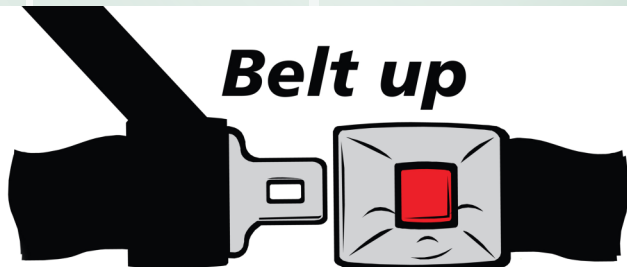

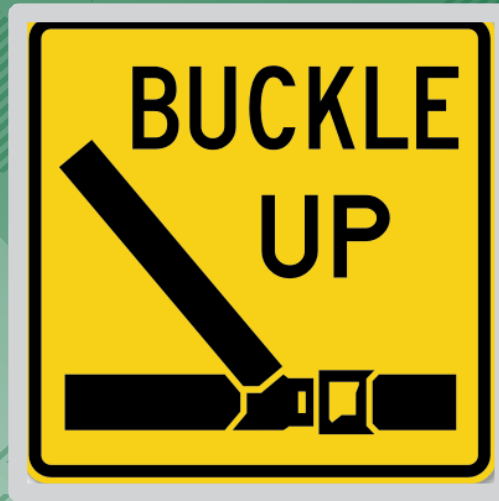


# Road Traffic Management Corporation

It is law that all vehicle occupants (rear and front) are to be buckled up at all times.

You should never travel unless the driver and all passengers are buckled-up.

Seatbelts help belted drivers to maintain control of the vehicle by keeping them in the driver seat.

By law the driver of a motor vehicle operated on a public road shall ensure that an infant traveling in such a motor vehicle is seated on an appropriate child restraint.
